Call to Order, Roll Call and Open Meeting Statement

Dr. Foy called the meeting to order at 8:45 am. Julie Drake read the open meeting statement and roll call indicated that a quorum was present.

Action Item. Approval of Institutional Renewal Application for Nashotah House Theological Seminary

Ms. Larson presented the SARA renewal application of the Nashotah House Theological Seminary (Attachment A) and provided background information as to why the application is before the Board.

The Nashotah House Theological Seminary has a U.S. Department of Education Federal Composite Score of 1.4. Institutions with a score between 1.0 and 1.4 can be approved provisionally by the state's portal entity. The Nashotah House Theological Seminary's previous SARA application was approved provisionally due to a score of 1.4 and there have not been changes since the Board's last provisional status vote. Nashotah House Theological Seminary has not received an updated score from the Department of Education in the interim. Nashotah has done everything it needs to do to provide justification of financial viability.

President Rothman asked what the standards are to approve this. Ms. Larson explained that SARA aligns with Department of Education standards.

It was moved by President Rothman, seconded by Dr. Fulcomer to approve the Nashotah House Theological Seminary's institutional renewal application on a provisional basis, effective immediately. Motion carried unanimously.
