WISCONSIN STATE STUDENT FINANCIAL AID DATA FOR 2007-08**

The series of exhibits in this Board Report present 2007-08 academic year student financial aid information for Wisconsin resident undergraduates. The colleges and universities within the four different Wisconsin higher education sectors provided the majority of the information reflected in these exhibits. Data was collected by HEAB through the annual Wisconsin Student Support Information System (WISSIS) survey, which is authorized by section HEA 1.02 of the State Administrative Code. The four higher education sectors in Wisconsin include the Independent Colleges and Universities, the Tribal Colleges, the University of Wisconsin System, and the Wisconsin Technical College System.

**Loans as percentage of all Financial Aid**

The percentage of all financial aid that is subject to repayment is increasing. In 06-07 it was 54.67% and for 07-08 it was 55.92%

Our students are assuming a great deal of debt each year to obtain their education.

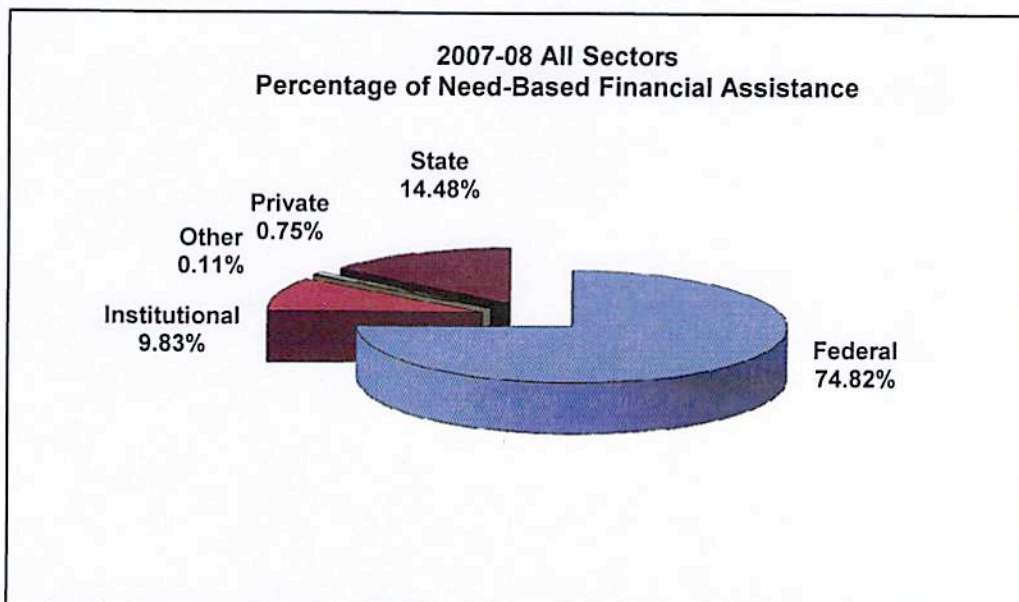

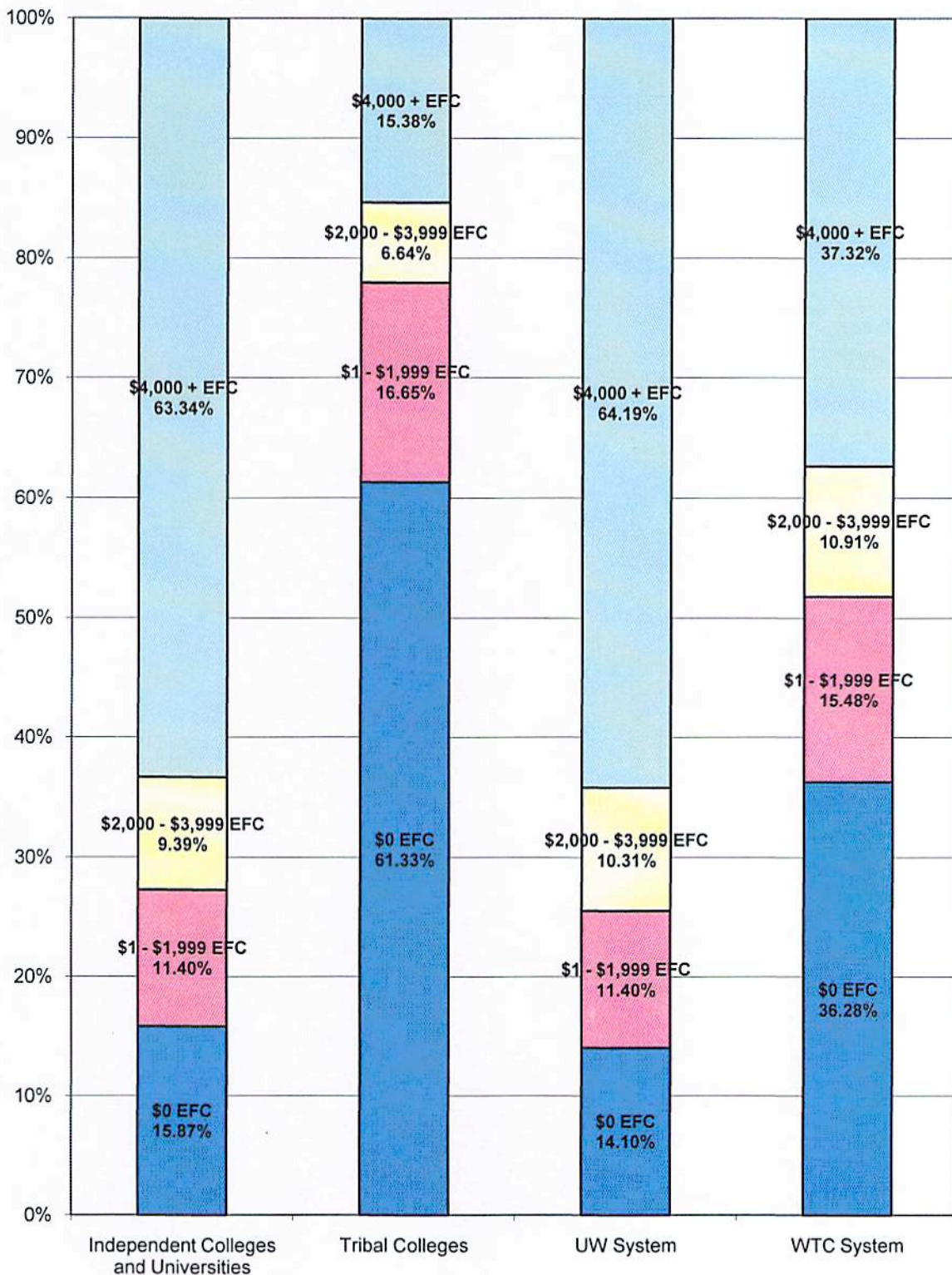

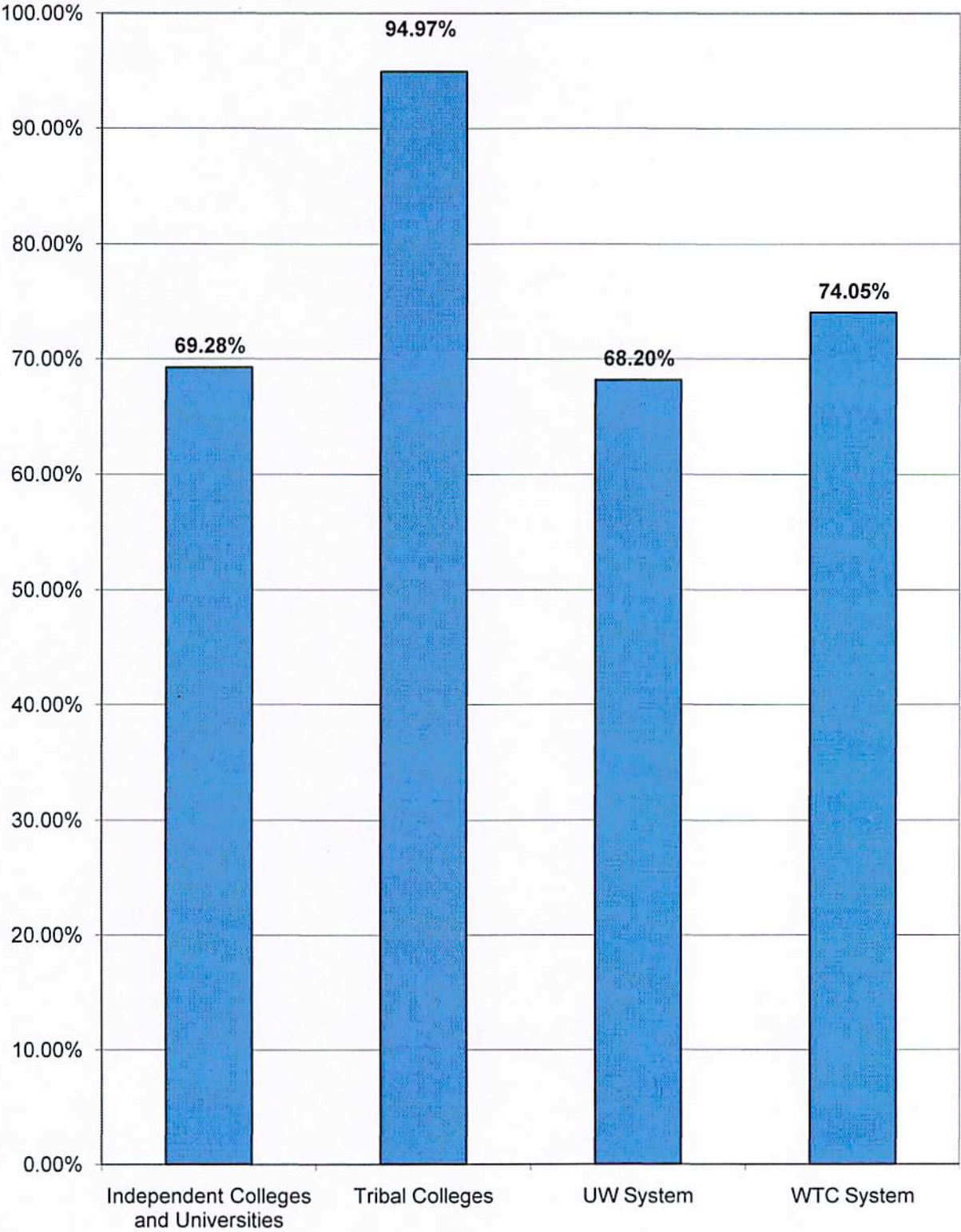

Year-end 2007-08 data above includes Wisconsin resident undergraduates, awarded and unawarded, for the FAFSA filer's first school only.

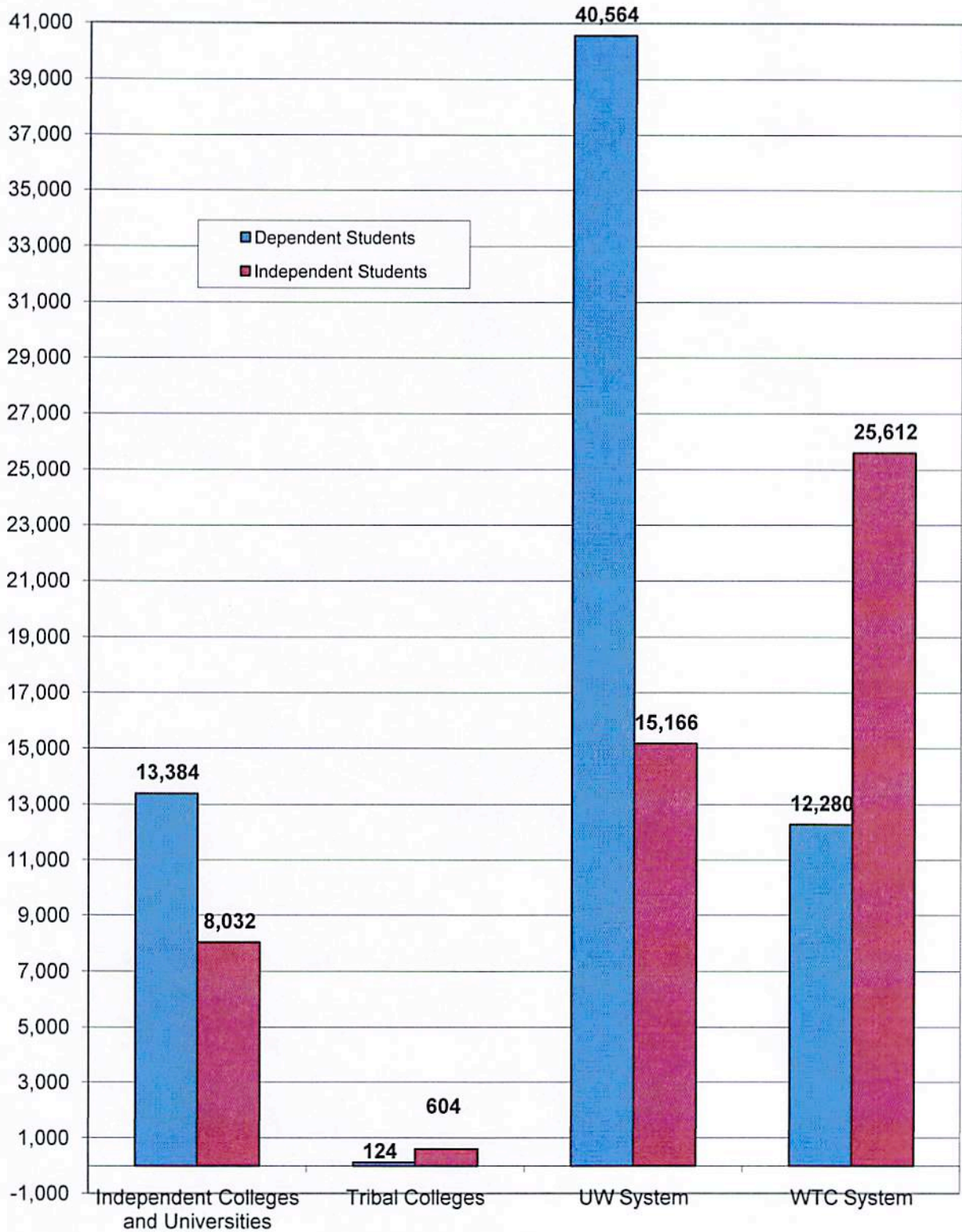

 Dependency Status of Need-Based Aid Recipients

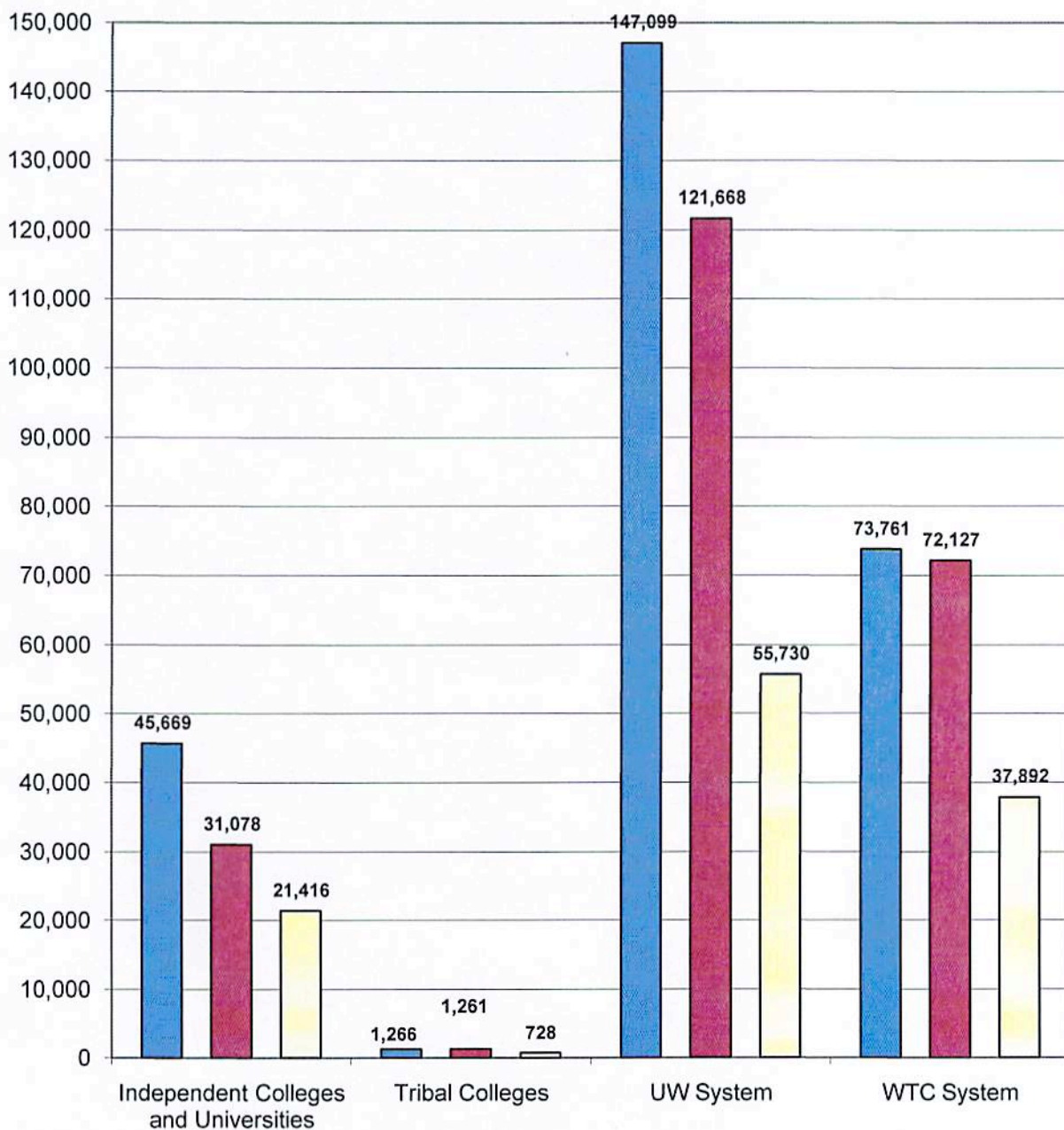

- Wisconsin-resident undergraduate students enrolled at least half-time in degree or certificate programs who filed the FAFSA and received need-based aid.

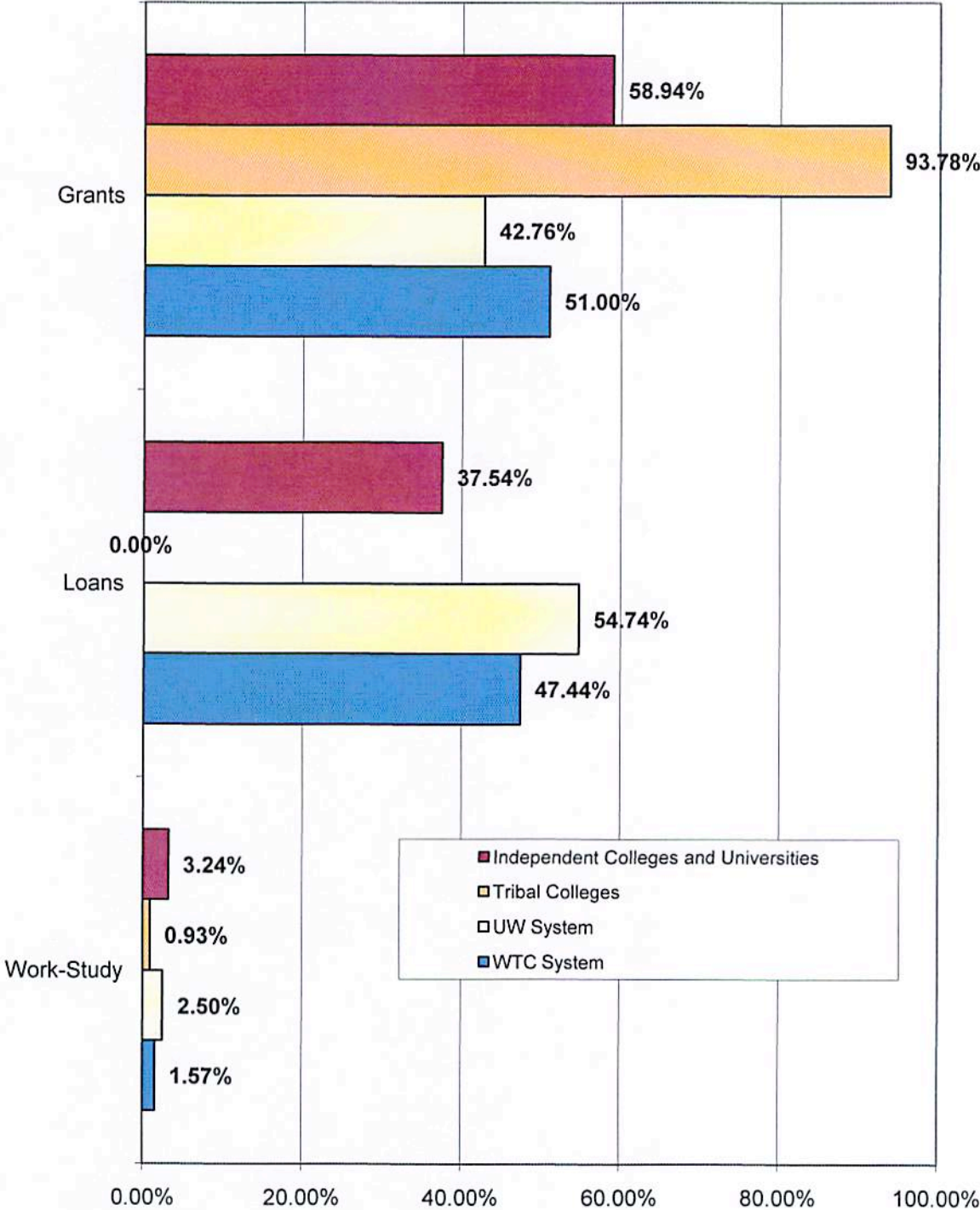

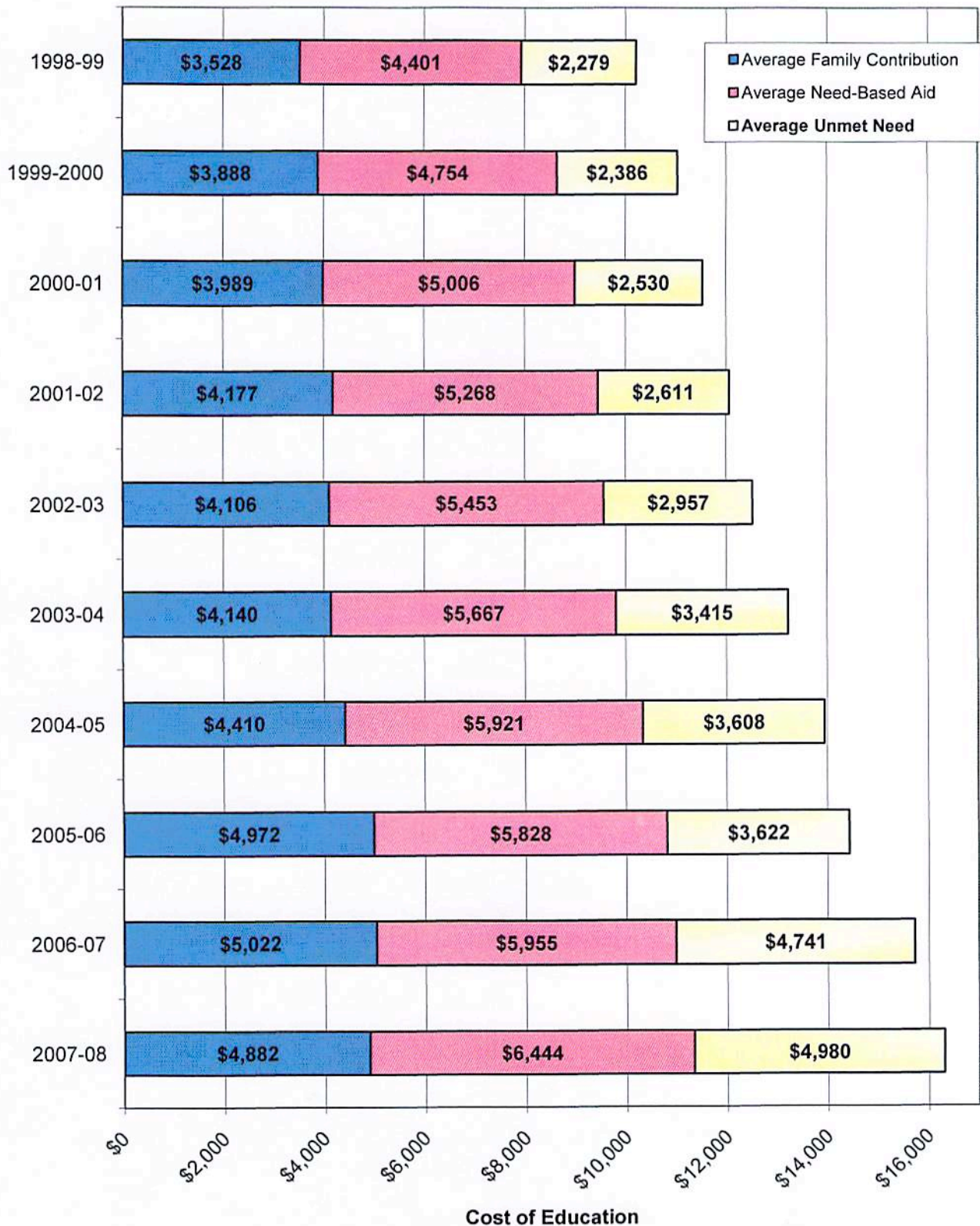

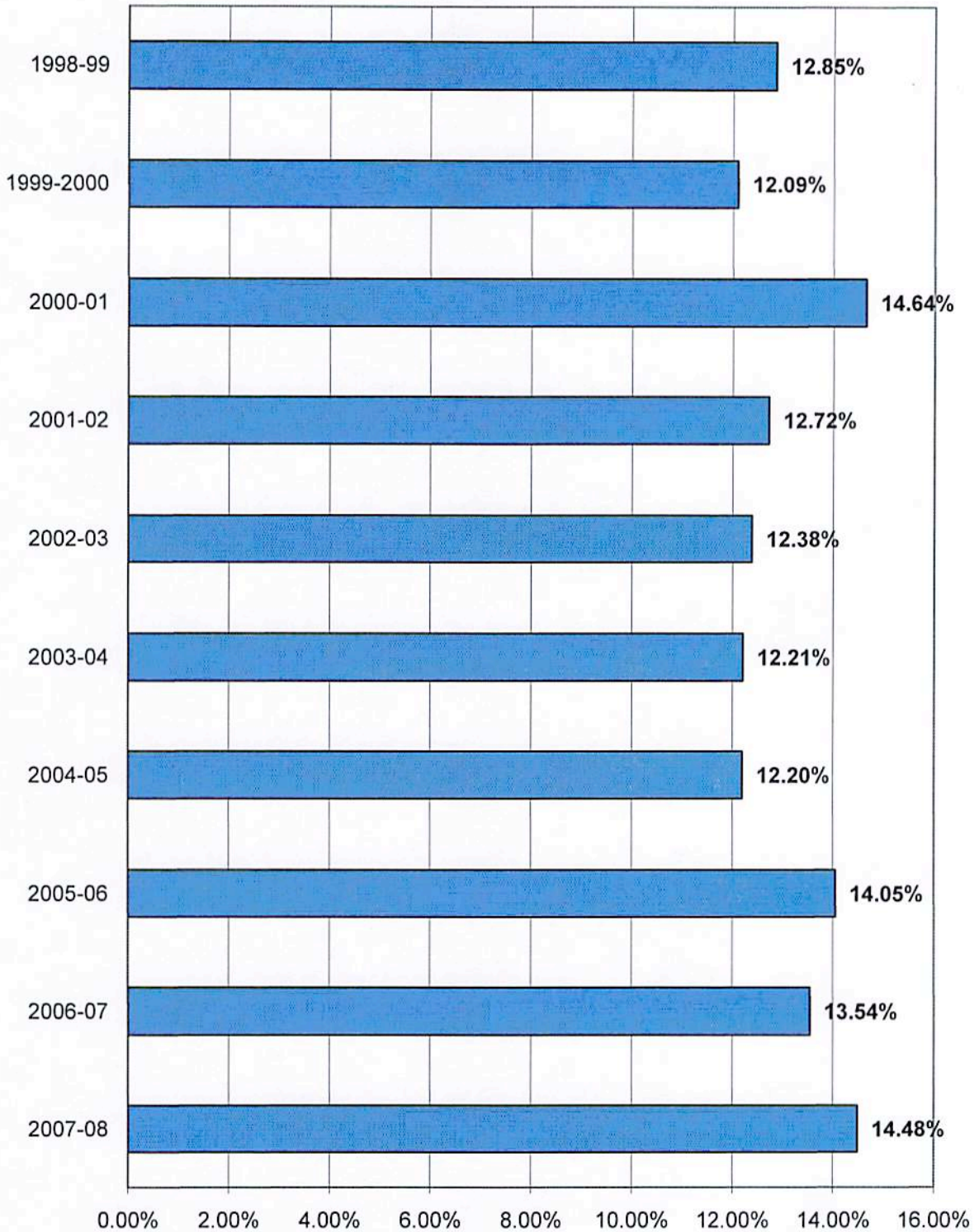

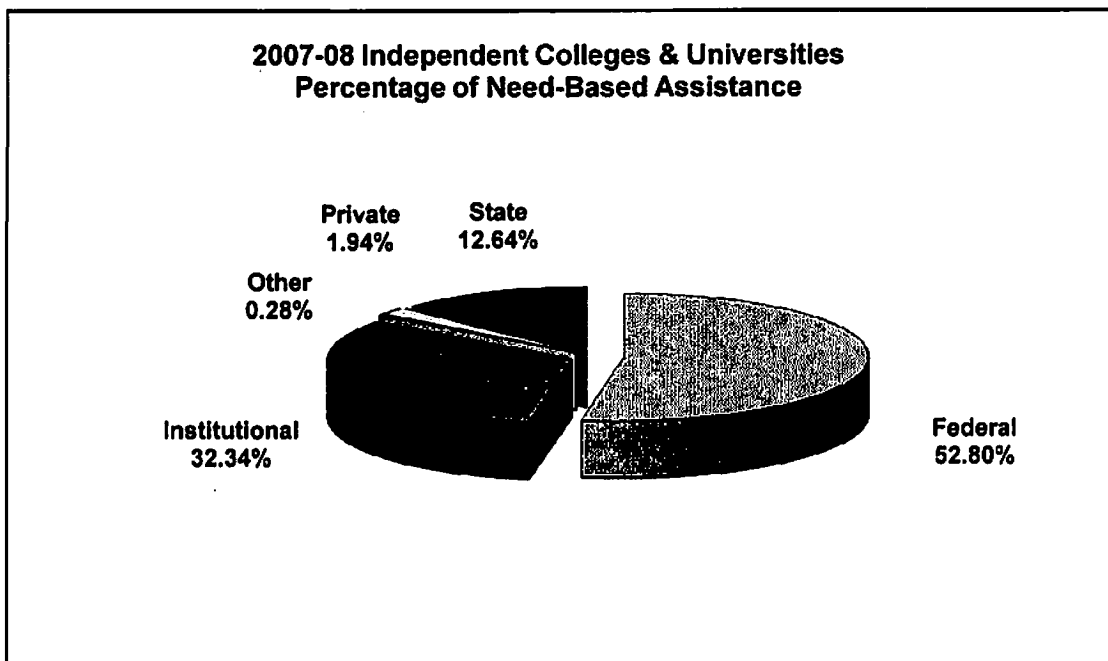

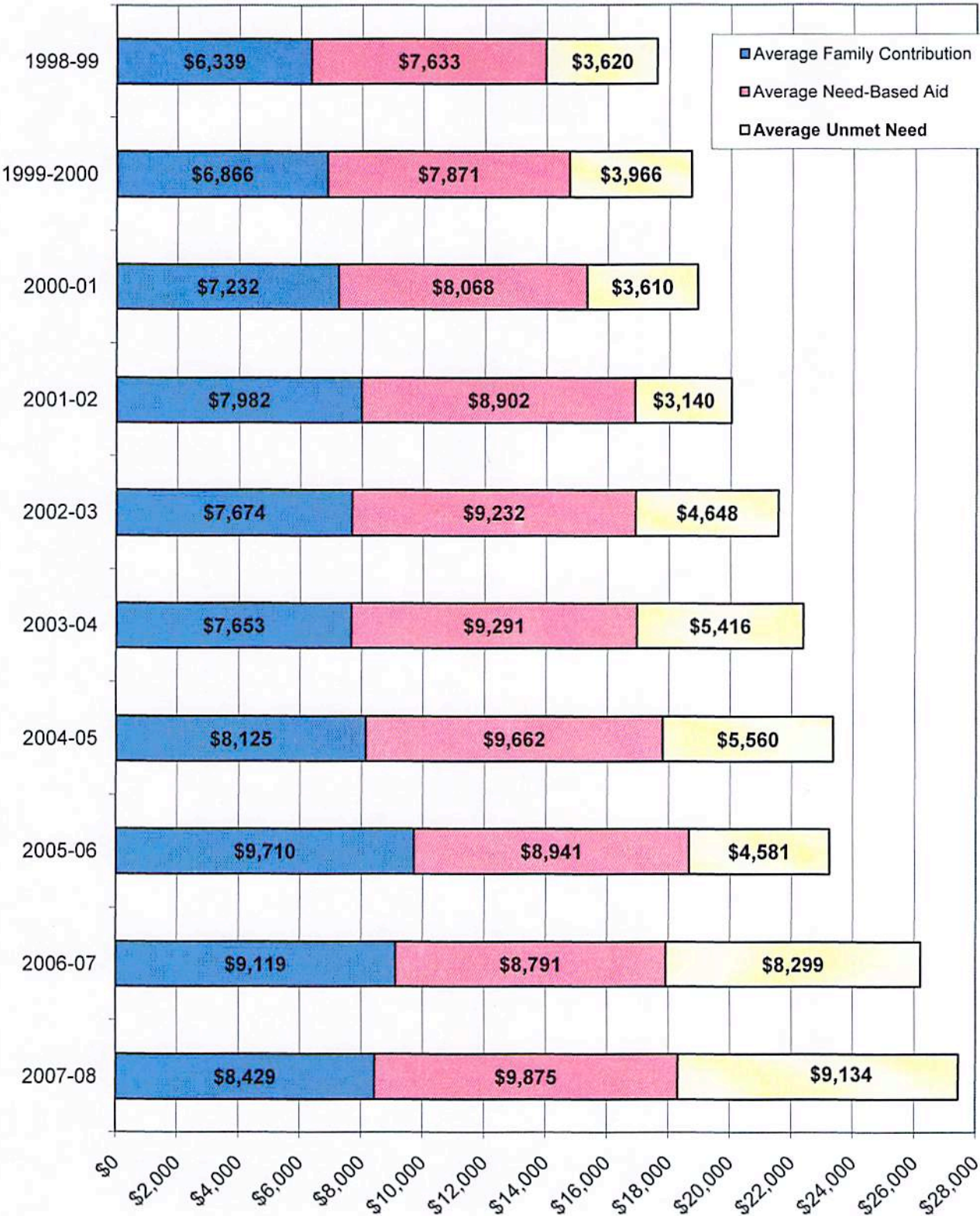

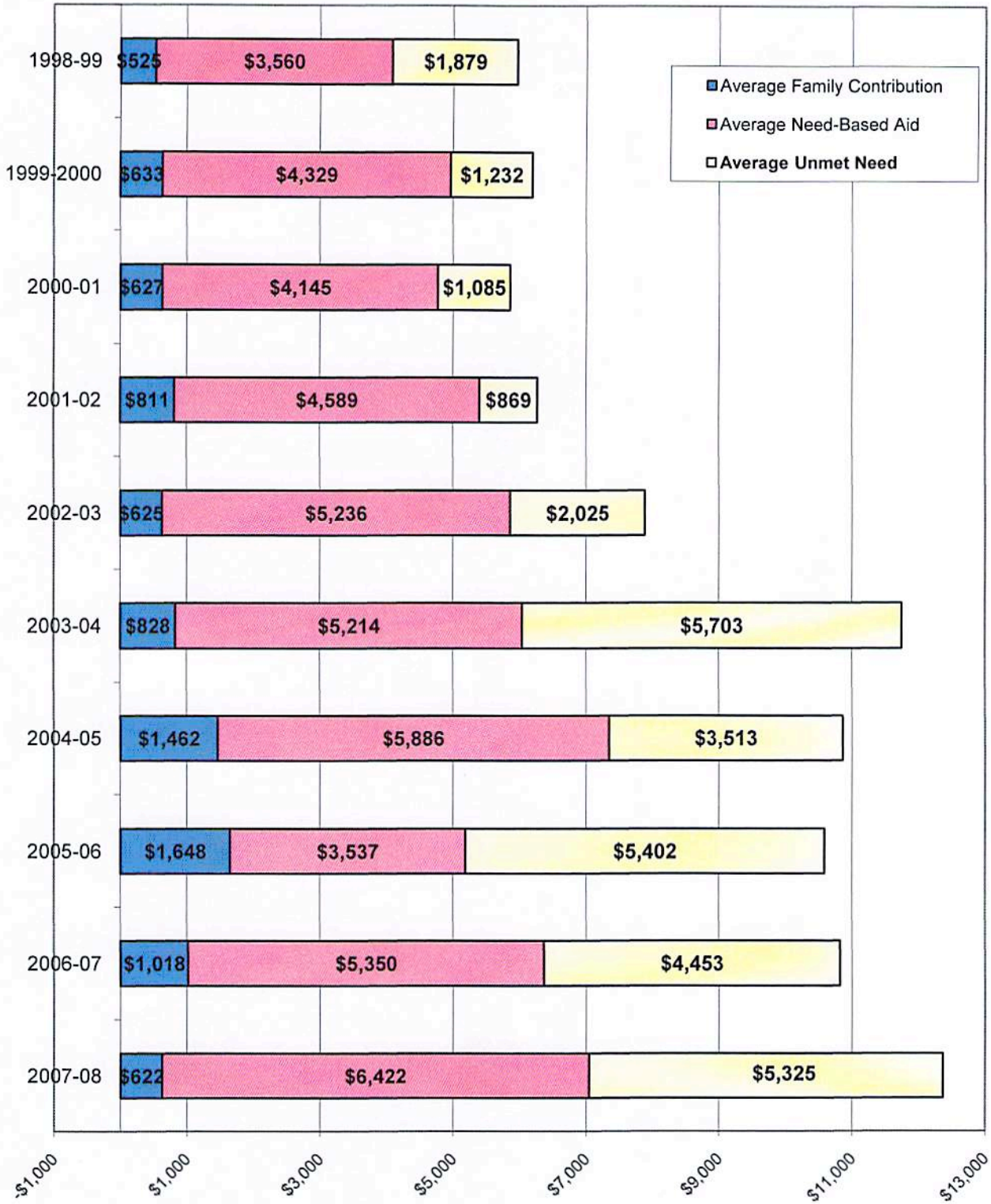

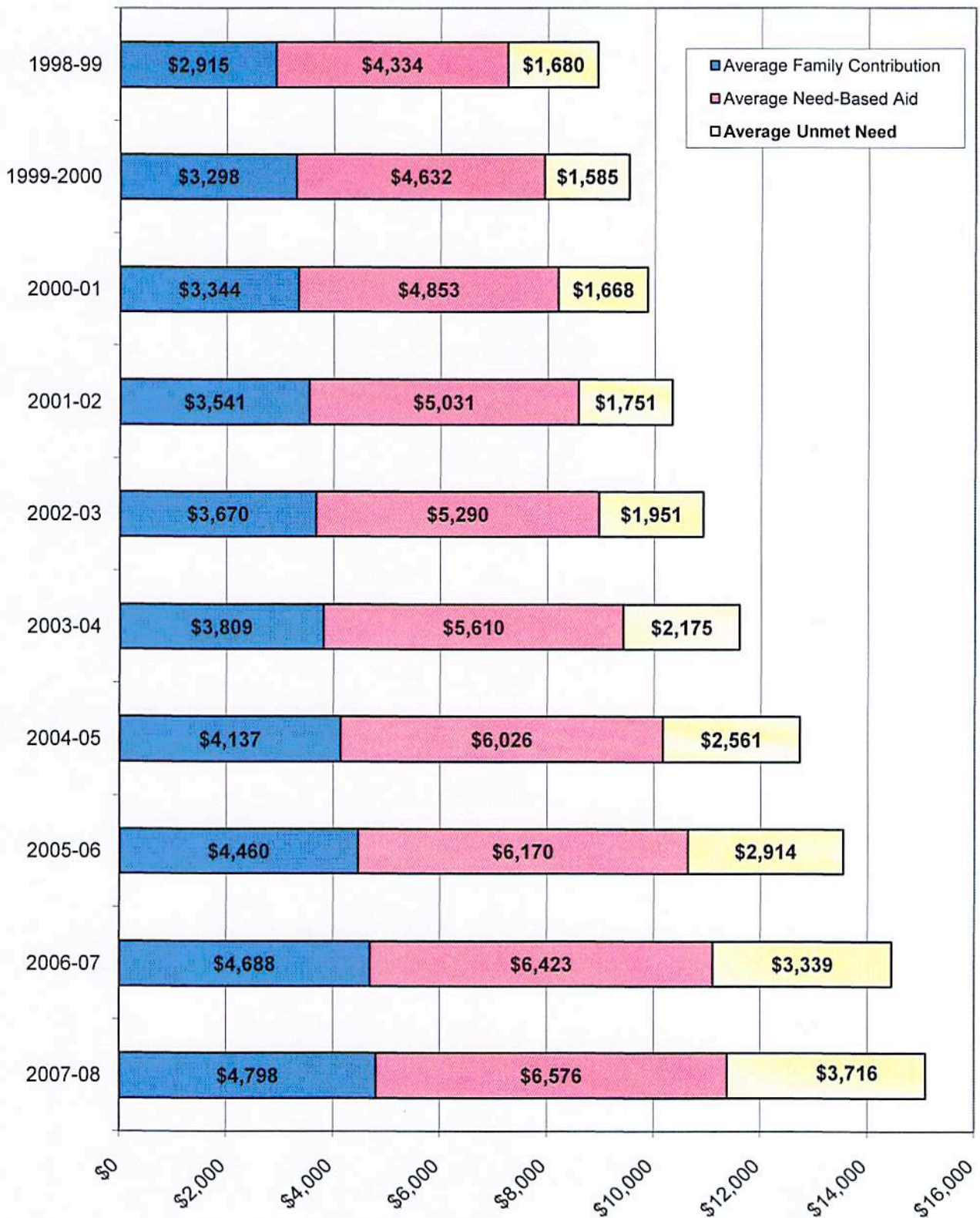

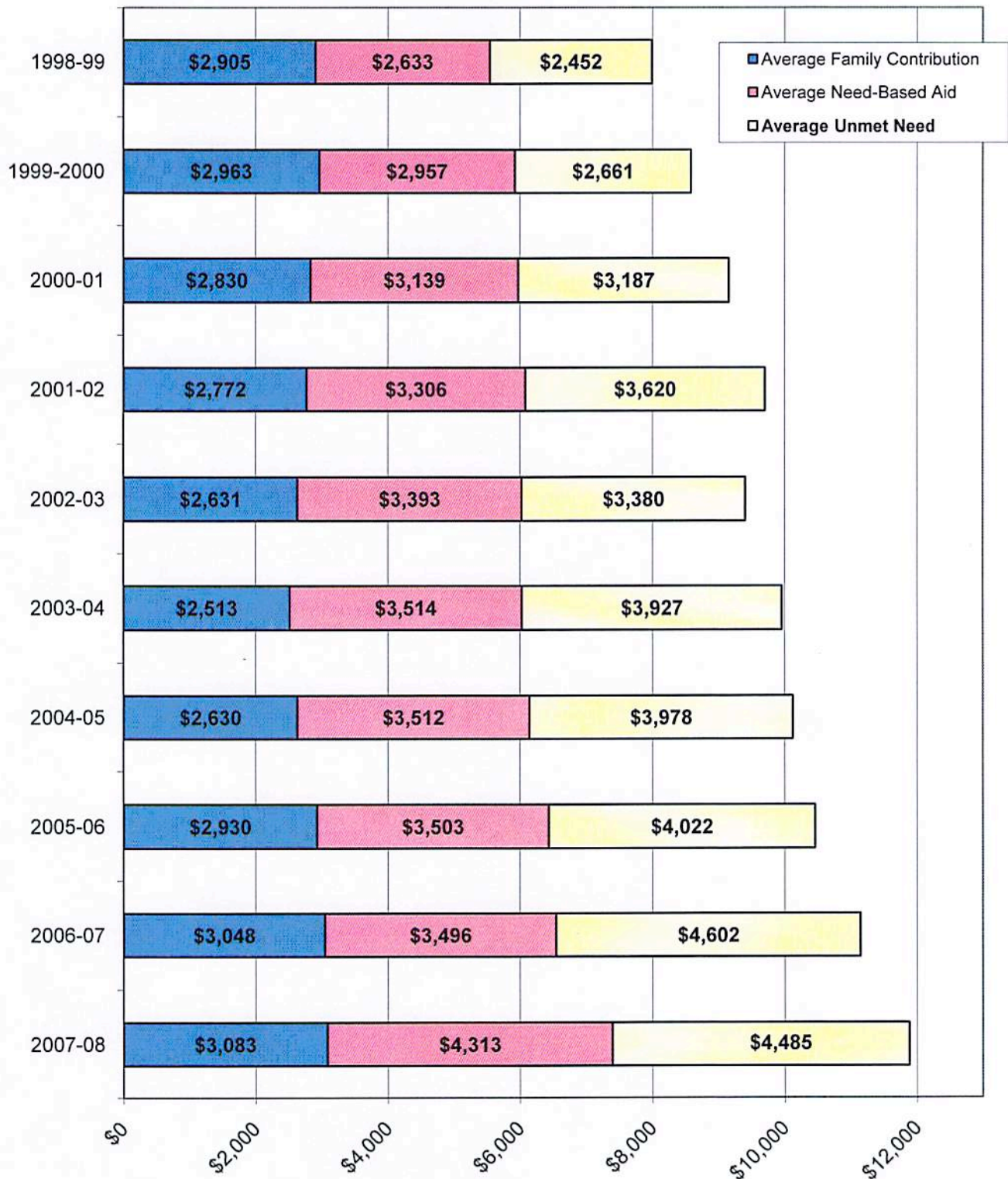

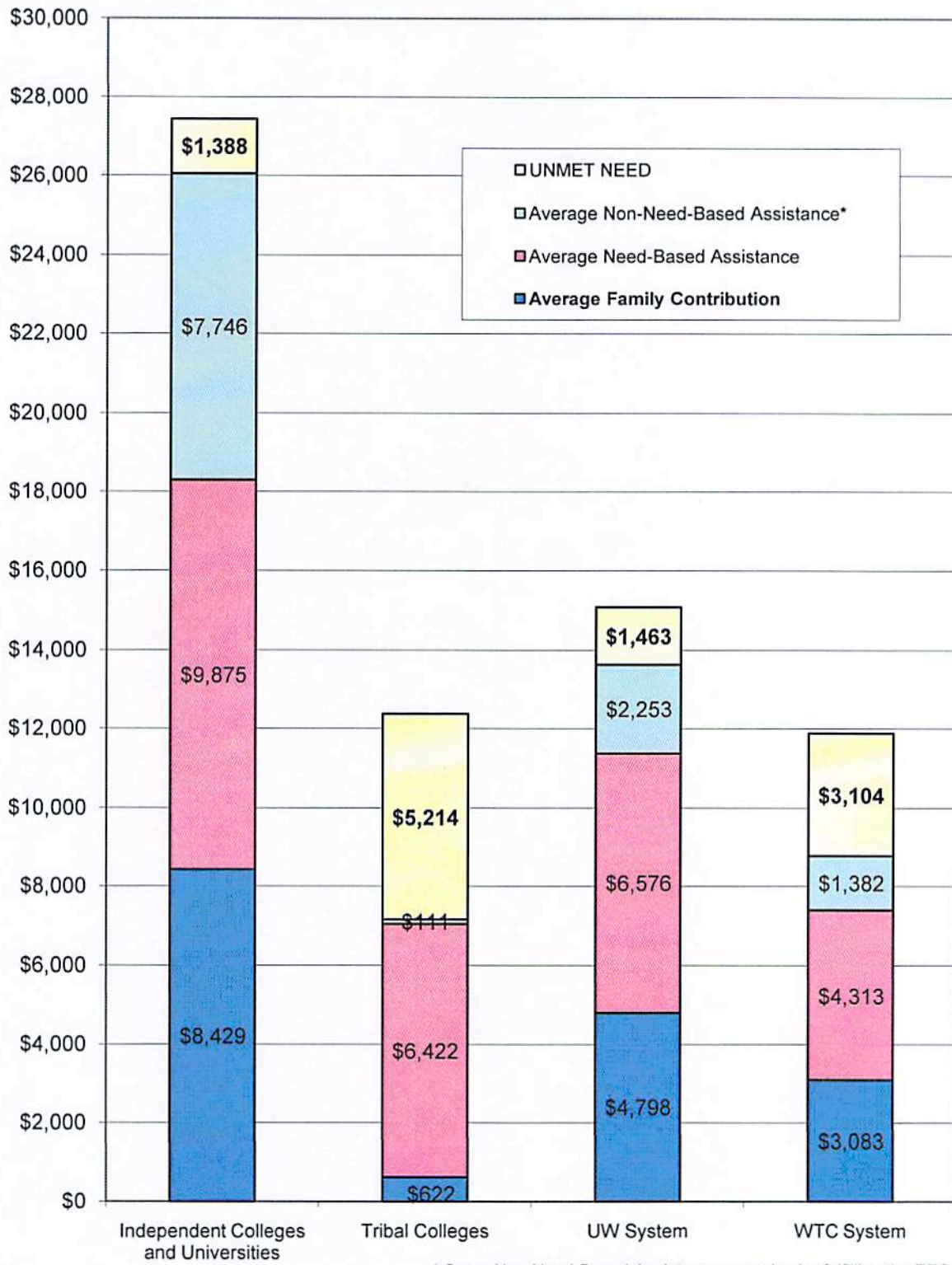
