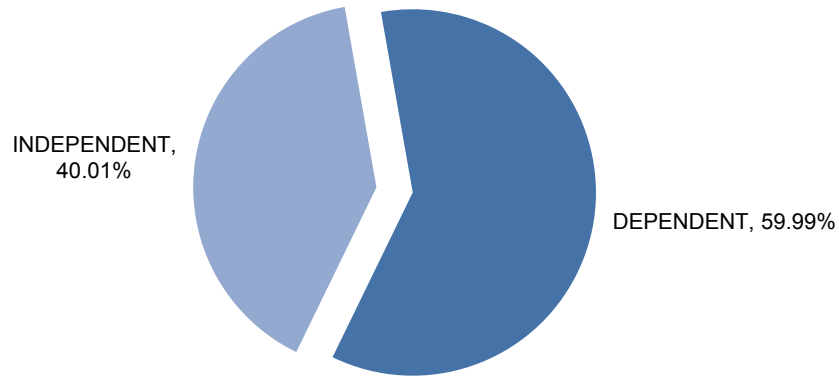

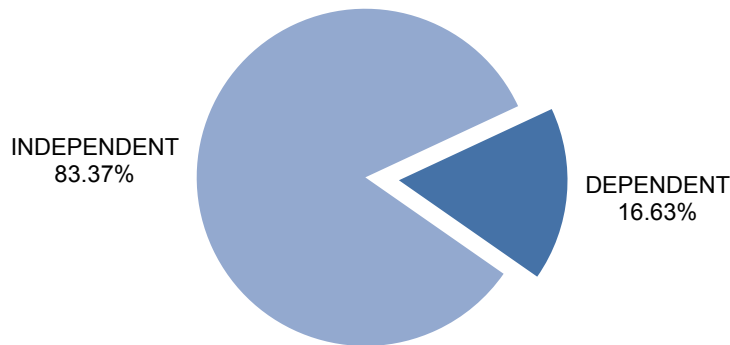

Spent by Dependency Status



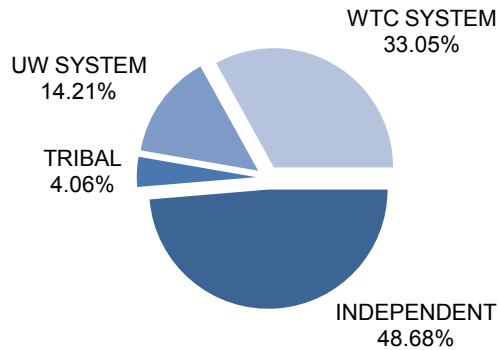

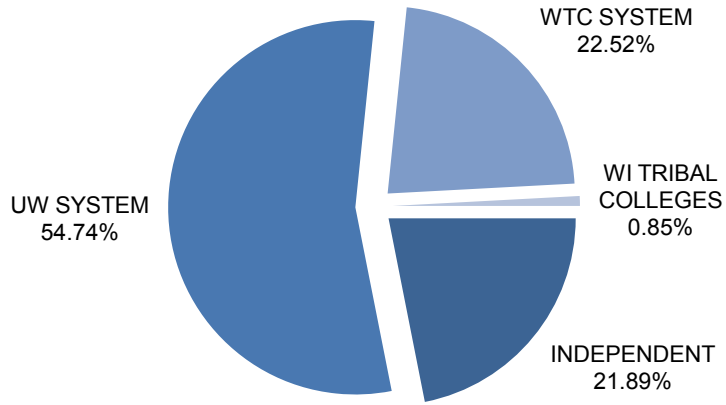
