Teacher Loan Program: Rural County List

Only work performed in a primary or secondary school in one of these designated areas is an eligible work location for forgiveness purposes.

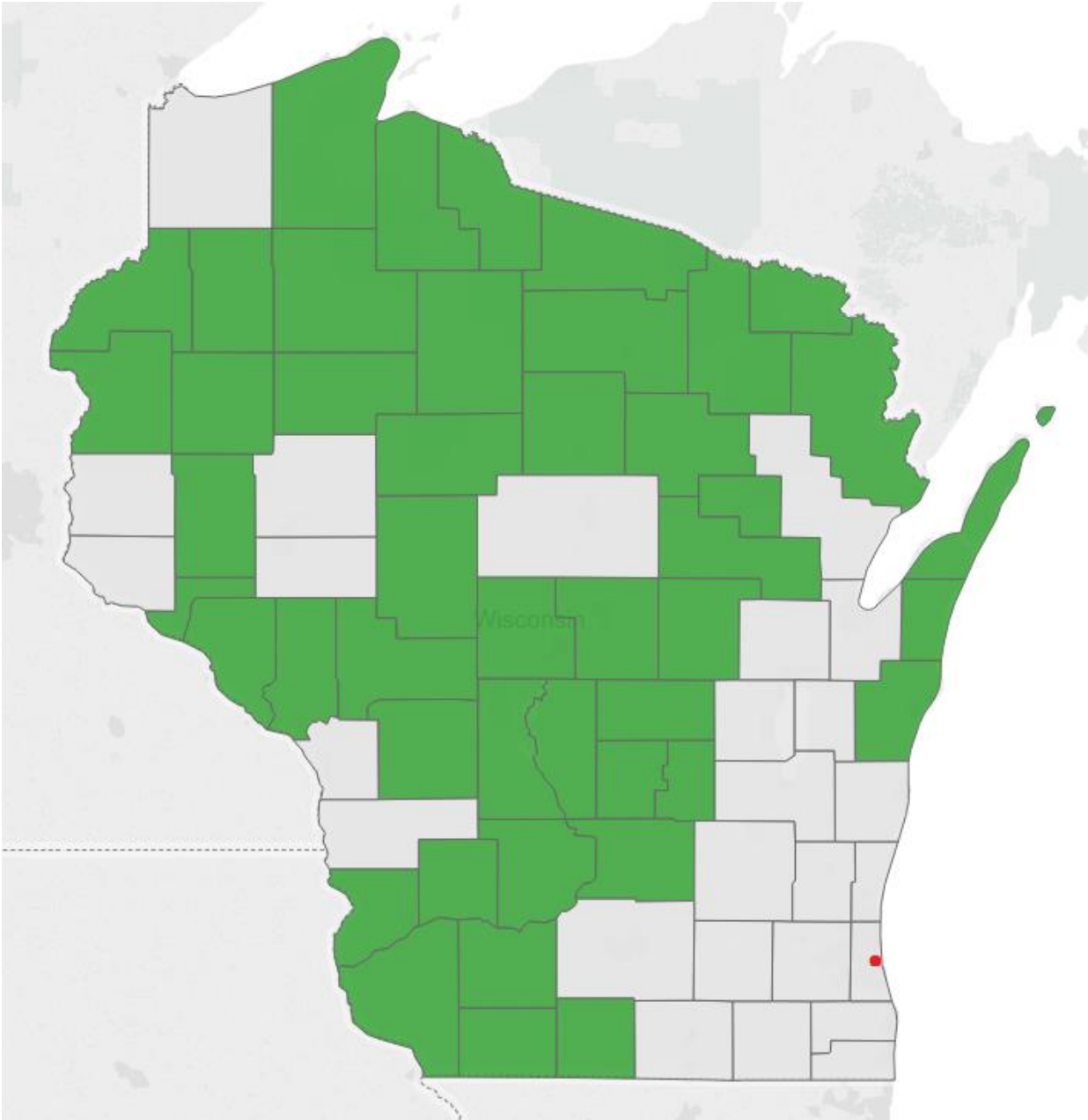
