

DENTAL EDUCATION CONTRACT

WHITE PAPER FOR 2013-2015 BIENNIAL BUDGET REQUEST

The Higher Educational Aids Board would like to request an increase of \$1,311,700 GPR for the Dental Education Contract at the Marquette University School of Dentistry (MUSOD). The increase would restore the tuition subsidy from \$8,665 to \$11,670 per resident enrolled at the Marquette University School of Dentistry and also increase the number of Wisconsin residents eligible for the program from up to 160 (40 per class) to up to 200 (50 per class) and to be phased in over a four year program. The additional dollars requested only cover the first two years of the phase in. In 2013-14 up to 170 Wisconsin residents at \$11,670 per resident per year would be eligible; in 2014-15 up to 180 Wisconsin residents at \$11,670 would be eligible. Marquette University believes that it is in the best interest of the State to increase the number of Wisconsin residents eligible for support through the Dental Education Contract to enable more Wisconsin resident dental students to remain in our state to study and ultimately practice dentistry. This option was approved at the Higher Educational Aids Board meeting on August 3, 2012.
